
### Pastor Miles McPherson to speak at The Gathering

Pastor Miles McPherson, one of the country's most respected leaders in evangelical circles, will be the keynote speaker at The Gathering in Waco, Texas on April 9th at 6:30 p.m., in McLane Stadium.

Born in Brooklyn, New York, in March 1960, the second oldest of five children, McPherson was raised on Long Island in a strong family. After excelling in football throughout high school, he attended the University of New Haven, where he majored in engineering. McPherson was the university's first player to achieve All-American honors in football and be drafted into the NFL. Strong athletics run in the McPherson family; Miles' brother, Don McPherson, was a Heisman Trophy runner-up in 1987.

Pastor Miles McPherson played four years in the NFL

with the San Diego Chargers from 1982-1985. It was during this time that he developed a cocaine addiction that found the NFL star in a tailspin as he began feeding his habit.

After his second season in the NFL and after a weekend-long drug binge, he called out

to Jesus Christ, accepted Him and stopped doing drugs in one day.

Miles worked as a Youth Pastor for Horizon Christian Fellowship in San Diego and enrolled in Azusa Pacific University's School of Theology, receiving his Master's of Divinity degree in 1991.

In 2000, he felt called by God to start the Rock Church in San Diego. According to Outreach Magazine, the Rock has consistently been one of the nation's fastest growing and largest churches, with nearly 15,000 people attending one of the Rock's fifteen Sunday services, in addition to the services that are experienced through online streaming, Microsites, radio and TV.

In 2013, Pastor Miles initiated Do Something Church, which is dedicated

#### A BRIDGE CONNECTING WACO AND OTHERS

In 1869, the Waco Suspension Bridge was first opened for traffic across the Brazos River. Situated between Austin and Dallas, Waco was located on the important Chisholm Trail, the north-south route used to transport cattle from ranches in Texas to railheads in Kansas. But before the bridge was built, anyone wanting to cross the Brazos River relied on a ferry, a dangerous, if not time-consuming, prospect. This bridge served to more readily connect communities of people and businesses that once struggled to cross the expansive Brazos River. In one day, a bridge was crossed that continues to stand 146 years later.

On Palm Sunday, April 9, 2017 from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. another kind of bridge is being built in Waco, one between the church and the community. On this night an historic event will take place at Baylor's McLane Stadium where The Church of Waco and beyond will come together for one evening to worship God in one place! It will be a fantastic Pre-Easter celebration featuring Miles McPherson and local testimonies including Coach Scott Drew. In addition, a combined mass choir will join in the worship celebration under the leadership of Dr. Jimmy Hunter and Gary Rhodes,

### Grudges Hurt: How to forgive and forget

(NewsUSA) - The pace of daily life can be hectic, and when certain personalities collide, sometimes people disagree.

Sound familiar? It's impossible to navigate the world without ever running into conflict with another person. But carrying grudges can be destructive to your emotional and physical wellbeing. In 2009, researchers at the Department of Psychology at Medical College of Georgia published a survey, which revealed that those who don't forgive can experience more pain disorders, heart

disease and stomach ulcers.

"Holding onto negativity causes harm to the one who won't forgive," says Dr. Matthew B. James, president of The Empowerment Partnership.

Refusing to forgive can have widespread effects too, it can create chains of resentment throughout entire communities. "When you point a finger at someone to blame them, there are always three fingers pointing back at you," says Dr. James.

But letting go of old hurts isn't easy. Dr. James suggests that grudge-bearers take the

following steps to seek true forgiveness:

- Tell the other person that you forgive them. Don't say that you will "forgive, but not forget" -- the goal is to release negative feelings.

- Ask the other person to forgive you. Ask for forgiveness even if you believe that you did nothing wrong. "Saying, 'I forgive you; please forgive me, too' brings the other person into the picture and gets them actively involved," says Dr. James.

- Have a conversation. Create enough space for you and the other person to say

everything that needs to be said. Stay calm and speak in normal tones, even if you don't like what you hear. At the end of your talk, you should feel relieved to have gotten your thoughts and feelings into the open. Give and ask for forgiveness once more.

- Move on. Ask yourself what you have learned from the situation, and use it to make better decisions in the future.

"To forgive and to never forget is to never forgive in the first place," says Dr. James. "We owe it to ourselves to experience true forgiveness."

## The President-elect, Mr. Donald J. Trump! What if he is God's choice? Part 3

By using the name, Jesus, Peter and John had gotten a forty-year old man healed, who had been crippled from birth. The Council was amazed when they saw the boldness of the two. They recognized that they were ordinary men with no special training in the Scriptures, but couldn't help notice that they had been with Jesus, whom they had crucified (Acts 4:12-14; 5:33-39). The Council wouldn't let the disciples go until they had beaten, and threatened them not to teach any more in the name of Jesus (Acts 5:40-42). The disciples praised God that they were counted worthy to be beaten for His cause.

President Trump is not doing business as usual, yet he's

getting things done—through persecution. My advice is the same as Gamaliel's: leave him alone because you are fighting against God, and can't win!

God used Moses to bring the Jews (Israel) out of Egypt in route to their "Promised Land". They had to pass through the plains of Moab. The Moabite king sent for Balaam to come and curse them. Balaam wanted the honor and wealth that King Balak promised, although God warned him not to go. He insisted, so God told him that he could go but only say what He'd tell him.

In route to the king, Balaam's donkey saw an angel with a drawn sword to kill Balaam because he had stubbornly resisted. The donkey tried to get out of the way which caused him to get a beating. This happened three times. The donkey was trying to save his master's life. Balaam, being spiritually blind, couldn't see what his animal saw. God finally gave the donkey the ability to talk in order to defend itself. Balaam told the donkey that he would have killed him if he'd had a sword. Even the angel asked him why he had beaten the donkey three times. He

said that he could have killed him and spared the donkey (Numbers 22:1-41).

Although they build seven altars and sacrificed seven young bulls and seven rams on them, it was for naught. This was the message God caused Balaam to pronounce: "Balak summoned me to come from Aram; the king of Moab brought me from the eastern hills. 'Come,' he said, 'curse Jacob for me! Come and announce Israel's doom.' But how can I curse those whom God has not cursed? How can I condemn those whom the Lord has not condemned? I see them

from the cliff tops; I watch them from the hills. I see a people who live by themselves, set apart from other nations. Who can count Jacob's descendants, as numerous as dust? Who can count even a fourth of Israel's people? Let me die like the righteous; let my life end like theirs" (Numbers 23:7-10).

"Then King Balak demanded of Balaam, 'What have you done to me? I brought you to curse my enemies. Instead, you have blessed them!' But Balaam replied, 'I will speak only the message that the Lord puts in my mouth'" (Numbers 23:11, 12).

Balak sent Balaam to another place to curse Israel, but met the LORD Who told him to go back to Balak to deliver this message. "Rise up, Balak and listen! Hear me, son of Zippor. God is not a man, so He does not lie. He is not human, so He does not change his mind. Has He ever spoken and failed to act? Has He ever promised and not carried it through? Listen, I received a command to bless; God has blessed, and I cannot reverse it! No misfortune is in His plan for Jacob; no trouble is in store for Israel. For the Lord their God is with them; He has

been proclaimed their king. God brought them out of Egypt for them he is as strong as a wild ox. No curse can touch Jacob; no magic has any power against Israel. For now it will be said to Jacob, 'What wonders God has done for Israel!' These people rise up like a lioness, like a majestic lion rousing itself. They refuse to rest until they have feasted on prey, drinking the blood of the slaughtered!" Then Balak said to Balaam, "Fine, but if you won't curse them, at least don't bless them! But Balaam replied to Balak, 'Didn't I tell you that I can do only what the LORD tells me'" (Numbers 23:13-26). Please read Balaam's third blessing and final message in Chapter 24.

This is similar to what's happening now. If you can't say anything good, just don't say anything! Let's unite, Americans, become the UNITED states and love each other! You may not believe me, but...just what if I'm right?




